Direction to NIST Admin Building 101, Lecture Room B:

From Rt 495 (Beltway), take Rt 270 north to Gaithersburg.

On Rt 270, after the Shady Grove Exit, start looking for exit 10 and move from the Rt 270 high-speed lanes to the local lanes.

Take exit 10, or Rt 117 Clopper road (NIST) exit.

Circle around and take a right at the light and follow the road bearing left for about 1/4 mile. The next light is Bureau Drive and the NIST front entrance is on your left.

Come into the entrance, tell the guard you have been registered and need to pick up a visitor badge. The guard will direct you to the visitor center to get your badge.

After you obtain your visitor badge, please drive to the Stop sign (North Drive) and make a left. Follow the road and make the first left. There is a parking lot on your right. Drive all the way down close to the Administration Building 101, which is the tallest building on your right.

Park your car and enter the front entrance of the building. After you enter the door, take a left turn and Lecture B is down on your right, next to Lecture room A
